The bible says in Proverbs 29:18 Where there is no vision, the people are unrestrained. This simply means that, when we have no vision, we can go in any direction in life. It really doesn't matter because we have no goal in mind. But where there is a clear vision, there must be discipline and hard work. We are no longer free to just go in any direction because a clear target is set before us.

Any athlete that has a vision of winning the championship is no longer free to do as he or she pleases. Discipline and daily training become a vital part of every movement in their life. The vision of a championship takes hold of their life and will not let go until they have reached the finish line.

Pray you will see clearly God's vision for your life that inspires people and glorifies God. Pray also that you will have a vision from God about the ministry he has in mind for you.

Gen 12:1 The LORD said to Abram, "Leave your country, your relatives, and your father's family, and go to the land I will show you.

Give me eyes to see new territories you have for me to pioneer.

Gen 15:1 After these things happened, the LORD spoke his word to Abram in a vision: "Abram, don't be afraid. I will defend you, and I will give you a great reward."

Help me overcome every fear about tackling a God-size vision.

Gen 15:6 Abram believed the LORD. And the LORD accepted Abram's faith, and that faith made him right with God.

> Give me faith to fully trust you in the vision you give me.

MONDAY

The vision of Isaiah to see mission possibilities

Isa 6:1 In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a very high throne. His long robe filled the Temple.

 Help me to have a clear vision of your holiness.
Isa 6:5 I said, "Oh, no! I will be destroyed. I am not pure, and I live among people who are not pure, but I have seen the King, the LORD All-Powerful."

Show me the sin in my life and guide me to always repent.

Isa 6:8 Then I heard the Lord's voice, saying, "Whom can I send? Who will go for us?" So I said, "Here I am. Send me!"

Open my eyes to see the mission opportunities all around me.

TUESDAY

The vision of Jeremiah to see God's plan

Jer 1:11 The LORD spoke his word to me, saying: "Jeremiah, what do you see?" I answered, "I see a stick of almond wood." 12 The LORD said to me, "You have seen correctly, because I am watching to make sure my words come true."

Guide me to see your word clearly and proclaim it forcefully.

Jer 29:11 I say this because I know what I am planning for you," says the LORD. "I have good plans for you, not plans to hurt you. I will give you hope and a good future.

Help me clearly see your plans for good, even in difficult times.

Jer 29:12 Then you will call my name. You will come to me and pray to me, and I will listen to you.

Guide me to have a vision for growing in prayer.

Jer 29:13 You will search for me. And when you search for me with all your heart, you will find me!

Help me to have a passion for you and in helping others find you.

WEDNESDAY The vision of Ezekiel to see a new movement of God's Spirit

Ezek 37:1 I felt the power of the LORD on me, and he brought me out by the Spirit of the LORD and put me down in the middle of a valley. It was full of bones.

Show me how to minister effectively to those without your Spirit.

Ezek 37:2 He led me around among the bones, and I saw that there were many bones in the valley and that they were very dry.

Help me never lose sight of people who need the spirit of God.

Ezek 37:3 Then he asked me, "Human, can these bones live?" I answered, "Lord GOD, only you know."

Lead me to see possibilities of people without your Spirit.

Ezek 37:4 He said to me, "Prophesy to these bones and say to them, 'Dry bones, hear the word of the LORD.

Lead me to faithfully proclaim your message that can bring life.

THURSDAY

The vision of Amos to see what is right in God's sight

Amos 7:7 This is what he showed me: The Lord stood by a straight wall, with a plumb line in his hand.

Lead me to always see your plumb line of right and wrong.

Amos 7:8 The LORD said to me, "Amos, what do you see?" I said, "A plumb line." Then the Lord said, "See, I will put a plumb line among my people Israel to show how crooked they are. I will not look the other way any longer.

Use me to live by and communicate what is right and wrong.

FRIDAY

The vision of Ananias to spot great leaders

Acts 9:12 Saul has seen a vision in which a man named Ananias comes to him and lays his hands on him. Then he is able to see again."

> Open my eyes to people you place in my life to mentor. Acts 9:13 But Ananias answered, "Lord, many people have told me about this man and the terrible things he did to your holy people in Jerusalem.

Protect me from being blinded by what seems impossible.

Acts 9:15 But the Lord said to Ananias, "Go! I have chosen Saul for an important work. He must tell about me to those who are not Jews, to kings, and to the people of Israel.

Guide me to be a voice of encouragement for new believers.

SATURDAY

The vision of Paul to see outreach opportunities

Acts 16:9 That night Paul saw in a vision a man from Macedonia. The man stood and begged, "Come over to Macedonia and help us." 10 After Paul had seen the vision, we immediately prepared to leave for Macedonia, understanding that God had called us to tell the Good News to those people.

Open my ears to the cry of people who need your help.
Acts 18:9 During the night, the Lord told Paul in a vision:
"Don't be afraid. Continue talking to people and don't be quiet.

 Help me to never allow fear to keep me from sharing Christ.

Acts 18:10 I am with you, and no one will hurt you because many of my people are in this city."

Help me consistently sense your presence in my life.
