

Scavenger Hunt!

To add some fun to memorizing a verse, try this fun scavenger hunt in your house.

Before telling the kids about it, print out this pdf and hide the phrases around the house, yard, or wherever fits your family best. You can choose to do verses 16 & 17 or just verse 16 depending on your children's age and stage. Both verse references are available and verse 16 ends after the first period.

Do your daily Holy Week reading with your kids and tell them you have a fun adventure planned for them. Give them instructions on where to look for your hidden messages and tell them how many there are (17 for both verses 10 for the first verse). Once they have found all the messages tell them a place to meet to put them all together.

Once the verses are put in order, read them aloud together a few times.

If time allows, let the kids hide the messages for you or for one another and play again!
