PRAYING DURING UNCERTAIN TIMES AND FEAR

"I am gripped by fear and trembling; I am overcome with horror.

Sunday

Monday

Exodus 14:13 "**Do not be afraid**. Stand firm and you will see the deliverance the Lord will bring you today.

- When I am afraid, help me to stand firm and trust in your deliverance.
- Guide us in trusting you during the threat of this pandemic and give wisdom to our leaders in finding solutions.

Tuesday

Exodus 20:20 "**Don't be afraid**," Moses answered them, "for God has come in this way to test you, and so that your fear of him will keep you from sinning!"

- When you allow my life to be tested, help me not fear but grow in my faith
- Work through this pandemic to purify us as a nation and confess our sins.

Wednesday

Psalm 46:1-2 God is our refuge and strength, always ready to help in times of trouble. So, **we will not fear** when earthquakes come and the mountains crumble into the sea.

- When trouble comes, heighten my awareness of your strength and guide me to grow in faith.
- Work through me to be a witness of our hope in you.

Thursday

Isaiah 35:4 Say to those with fearful hearts, "Be strong, and **do not fear**, for your God is coming to destroy your enemies. He is coming to save you."

- Help me to not fear but be able to stand strong in your strength.
- Let me be a voice of encouragement to those filled with fear.

Friday

Deuteronomy 31:6 Be strong and courageous. **Do not fear** or be in dread of them, for it is the Lord your God who goes with you. He will not leave you or forsake you."

- Keep me mindful that you will go before me today and I need not fear anything that comes my way.
- Go before those working on a solution for the virus and guide them with your wisdom.

Saturday
